NAPIA Membership and Dues Information

Public adjuster members are firms who employ insurance adjusters on a full-time and professional basis in the adjustment of first party claims for owners of fixed properties -- commercial, industrial, institutional, retail, and/or residential -- that have been damaged by causes covered by insurance.

Public Adjuster members shall not acquire any interest in salvaged property or participate in any way, directly or indirectly, in the reconstruction, repair or restoration of damaged property.

Membership Dues: Annual dues are determined by the number of licensed public adjusters in the organization. Dues are calculated as follows:

Principal (Regular Member)	\$750
Employee (Associate Member)	\$750
1099 Employee (Independent Contractor Member) Public adjusters who perform services on a full-time or part-time basis for or on behalf of a public adjusting member firm.	\$240

The maximum amount for any combination of Regular and Associate members is \$7,500 regardless of the firm size.

There is a charge of \$290 for each branch office. A firm's web address can be added to its online company listing in the NAPIA membership directory for an additional \$400.

Membership Promotional Program: NAPIA is offering a discount that allows public insurance adjusting firms to join at a substantial savings on annual membership dues. New members receive a 50% discount and a free website listing the first year.

Employee (Associate Member)	\$375
1099 Employee (Independent Contractor Member)	\$120

Members may not vote or hold a board position during the year of their discounted membership.

Current members or past members (within three years) are not eligible for this promotion.

Application Process: All applications are forwarded to the membership committee for review. This process takes approximately 30 days. Once an application is approved, annual dues will be calculated and an invoice will be sent to the primary contact listed on the application.

Membership applications that contain inaccurate or incomplete information will be rejected.
